**Noteworthy Calls for the Week**

**07/06/21-Entry to Vehicle-6000 Blk N. Baker Rd.**

Unknown subject(s) stole several items after entering a trailer. Theft occurred between 9:00 AM and 1PM. No suspect information was obtained.

**07/06/21-Burglary-4600 Blk N. Port Washington Rd.**

Officers were dispatched for a burglar alarm. Upon arrival they discovered a broken window on the west side. An ID card was located at the scene, and the subject on the ID was seen walking nearby. Upon viewing the camera footage this subject was not the one that was seen breaking into the building. The suspect on video took a black safe containing \$500.00.

**07/07/21-Neighbor Trouble-500 Blk W. Riverview Dr.**

Resident report that the neighbor across the street has been acting "passively aggressive" and has been leaving messages in chalk on the roadway adjacent to his driveway. Subject did not want police action, rather, just a report filed.

A tan truck was observed pulling a trailer with 4 golf carts on it. The vehicle fled when the driver saw a squad car.
